RECREATIONAL

For students participating for enjoyment without examination requirements.

ABOUT THIS PATHWAY

There is no pre-requisite for entry into the recreational stream. The Recreational Stream offers enjoyable, expressive dance training in a fun and supportive environment for learners who wish to dance recreationally while still developing strong technique and performance skills.

Our Recreational Pre-Teens and Teens Programme is specifically designed for students who love to dance and perform, but who may not wish to pursue formal vocational training or examinations.

The programme encourages confidence, creativity, musicality, fitness and a love for movement, while still providing quality technical training across a variety of dance styles. This stream offers a range of learning opportunities and enables participants to enjoy physical expression as well as develop intellectual sensibilities.

The students learn about co-operation and develop an understanding of the shaping of movement into artistic forms of expression. The program is concerned with progressive mastery in the defined stages within the context of safe dance practice



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VOCATIONAL

For students pursuing formal training and examinations.

GRADE PROGRESSION

- Primary & Grade 1 (Ages 5-10)
- Grade 2 & Grade 3 (Ages 11 – 13)
- Grade 4,5,6 & intermediate (Ages 14 -18)

ABOUT THIS PATHWAY

The Vocational Stream is designed for learners seeking more focused and intensive training. Students develop technique across all dance genres through the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing (ISTD), London, progressing through graded to advanced levels. This stream requires a greater level of commitment, including additional weekday classes alongside Saturday training, and culminates in internationally recognised ISTD accreditation.



Criteria for the Vocational Stream:

Throughout the study of the syllabus, students are following a vocational path, requiring a high level of commitment and with an increasing emphasis on safe dance practice.

Students at this level should show virtuosity in performance, a high standard of technique and a sound knowledge and understanding of the genre, including an understanding of reference and context.

Students should display a sense of self-awareness and be self-motivated in terms of their personal development. A greater degree of personal interpretation is encouraged and the student is expected to show the potential to communicate effectively with an audience.

Students need to show qualities of professionalism, commitment and focus with the ability to manage a greater workload.

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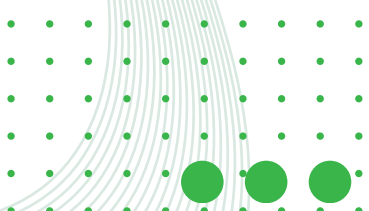
